RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

21^{ST} NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - Fourth Year 2010

AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND FINANCE; AMENDING TITLE 26 OF THE NAVAJO NATION CODE, 26 N.N.C. \$1002

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Findings

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby finds that current provisions of the Navajo Nation Code leave the matter of compensation of Navajo Nation Chapter officials to be determined each year through the Navajo Nation Budget Resolution.
- B. The Navajo Nation further finds that the determination of a statutorily fixed rate of compensation for chapter officials would provide for more uniformity in such compensation, and for additional stability in the governance of the Navajo Nation Chapters.
- C. The Navajo Nation determines that these amendments are in the best interests of the Navajo Nation and Navajo People.

Section Two. Amendment of Title 26 of the Navajo Nation Code

The Navajo Nation Council hereby amends Title 26 of the Navajo Nation Code, as follows:

NAVAJO NATION CODE ANNOTATED TITLE 26. NAVAJO NATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT CHAPTER 2. CHAPTER GOVERNMENT SUBCHAPTER 5. NAVAJO NATION CHAPTERS, OFFICIALS AND ADMINISTRATION-GENERALLY

§ 1002. Meetings; Meeting notice requirement; Compensation of chapter officials

- A. Number of meetings. Each chapter shall determine the number of meetings to be held each month and the time and place for such meetings (subject to the right of chapter president to call special or emergency meetings when necessary).
- B. Meeting notice. The chapter officials shall post all chapter meeting agendas within the chapter boundaries at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.
 - C. Compensation of chapter officials
- 1. Chapter officials shall be compensated for only the number of meetings provided for in the Navajo Nation approved budget. It is nonetheless the obligation of chapter officials to be present at all chapter meetings.
- 2. A chapter meeting claim form signed only by the claimant shall be attached to each of the regularly scheduled chapter meeting reports filed by the chapter secretary/treasurer with the chapter Government Development Department, Division of Community Development, or if applicable, by the chapter administration.
- a. Each regularly scheduled chapter meeting report and claim form shall be correctly filled out before it will be accepted and processed for payment by the Chapter Government Development Department, Division of Community Development, or if applicable, by the chapter administration;
- b. Each chapter president, vice president, secretary/treasurer (the appointed acting secretary and/or the chapter president protempore) shall be paid \$500 each for one regular chapter meeting and one chapter planning meeting per month in accordance with the approved fiscal year budget;
- c. No chapter official shall be compensated for a chapter meting unless he or she was in official attendance at that meeting; and
- d. Reports will be furnished for all chapter meetings, regular or special, and state whether or not chapter officials are to be compensated for attendance at such meetings.

Section Three. Effective Date

The provision of this Act shall become effective in accord with 26 N.N.C. \$1(E), which requires that amendments passed by the Navajo Nation Council are subject to approval of a majority of all chapters of the Navajo Nation. All chapters shall submit their chapter resolutions approving this amendment to the Executive Director, Office of Legislative Services for collection and determination of when the condition of approval by a majority of all chapters of the Navajo Nation has been met.

Section Four. Codification

The provisions of this Act which amend sections of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office Legislative Counsel.

Section Five. Savings Clause

Should any provisions of this Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or any other court of competent jurisdiction, those portions of this Act which are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.
